This responds to your letter dated September 7, 2009. We appreciate your commitment to working with the Forest Service and Town and County officials to find a solution to our housing needs.

We are currently preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Jackson Administrative Site. This EA will include alternatives for potential conveyance of part of the Jackson Administrative Site and potential development of the Jackson, Nelson and Cottonwood Administrative Sites. The EA will provide more detailed information on these projects and will include a period for public comment (further explained in my previous letter dated September 3, 2009). As stated previously, you are on our contact list and you will be notified once the EA is available for public comment.
