

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BRIDGER-TETON NATIONAL FOREST

WHEREAS, the Town of Jackson and Teton County support maintaining the location of the Bridger-Teton National Forest Supervisor's Office in Teton County; and

WHEREAS, the Bridger-Teton National Forest seeks to provide housing in Jackson and Teton County for the purpose of retaining and recruiting employees; and


WHEREAS, the Bridger-Teton National Forest has determined that additional housing units are needed to ensure an adequate supply of employee housing in order to support its Supervisor's Office in Teton County; and

WHEREAS, the Bridger-Teton National Forest possesses administrative land located in both the Town and County accessed from Nelson Drive; and


WHEREAS, Teton County, and the Town of Jackson are interested in the appropriate site design and building configuration at the Nelson Drive site that uses the smallest site footprint, is similar to the surrounding neighborhood in terms of density, and protects critical wildlife habitat.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Teton County, Wyoming and the Town Council of the Town of Jackson, Wyoming do hereby support the maintenance of the Supervisor's Office of the Bridger-Teton National Forest in Jackson, Wyoming and possible future development of the Nelson Drive Administration Site which uses the smallest site footprint, is similar to the surrounding neighborhood in terms of density, and protects critical wildlife habitat.

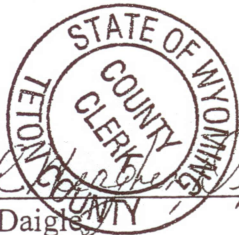
